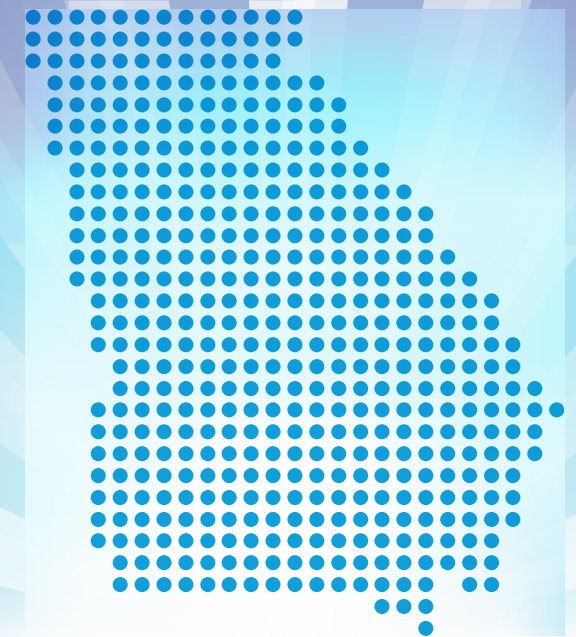


OUR MISSION
